



Residents age 25-64, including certificates and post-secondary degrees



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# **Credentials of Value**

- Industry Certification a time-limited credential issued by an independent, 3rd party certifying entity. Middle School through Postsecondary
- Digital Tool Certificate an independent, 3rd party assessment of digital skills in the following areas: word processing; spreadsheets; sound, motion, and color presentations; digital arts; cybersecurity. Awarded to students in elementary school and middle school grades. Grades K-8
- Apprenticeship Certificate of Completion signifies a registered apprentice has successfully completed the technical and academic standards of a registered apprenticeship program. (Issued by FDOE.) Postsecondary
- Applied Technology Diploma signifies a student has successfully completed technical instruction that is part of an A.S. degree leading to employment in a specific occupation. (May be issued by a school district or Florida College System institution.) Postsecondary




# **Credentials of Value**

- Career Certificate signifies a student has successfully completed a (clock hour) postsecondary career education program and is ready for employment in a field that requires non-college credit postsecondary training. (May be issued by a school district or Florida College System institution.) Postsecondary
- College Credit Certificate prepares students for entry into employment in a field that requires some college credit but less than a degree and signifies a student has successfully completed part of an A.S. degree. (Issued by a Florida College System institution.) Postsecondary
- Associate in Science Degree prepares students for occupations that require a two-year technical degree. (Issued by a Florida College System institution.) Postsecondary
- Bachelor's degree (workforce baccalaureate) prepares students for occupations that require a four-year degree. (Issued by a Florida College System institution.) Postsecondary

#### • <u>E0 19-32</u>

<u>A. Articulate how Florida will eliminate Common Core (Florida Standards) and ensure we return</u> to the basics of reading, writing and arithmetic;

**B. provide a roadmap to make Florida's standards number one in the nation;** 

<u>C. reflect the Commissioner's consultation with relevant stakeholders to include parents and teachers;</u>

D. deem how to increase the quality of instructional curriculum;

E. suggest innovative ways to streamline testing;

F. identify opportunities to equip high school graduates with sufficient knowledge of America's civics, particularly the principles reflected in the Unites States Constitution, so as to be capable of discharging the responsibilities associated with American citizenship; and

G. outline a pathway for Florida to be the most literate state in the nation.

# Florida Guidelines

- Student Performance Standards rule
- 6A-1.09401, Florida Administrative Code (FAC)

(2) The Commissioner shall periodically review, accept public comment on and revise Florida standards. <u>The process shall begin with convening an expert group to</u> <u>review the standards and make recommendations to the Commissioner for their</u> <u>review and revision</u>. The Commissioner shall determine whether revisions are necessary based on the recommendations of the expert group, and shall propose such revisions to the State Board of Education for adoption.




# **Expert Groups**

- The Commissioner shall periodically review, accept public comment on and revise Florida standards.
- The process shall begin with convening an expert group to review the standards and make recommendations to the Commissioner for their review and revision.
- The Commissioner shall determine whether revisions are necessary based on the recommendations of the expert group.

# FLORIDA STANDARDS TIMELINE



Release instructional materials alignment and specifications



#### February 2019

- Begin Standards Review Meetings
  - External and internal stakeholders
  - Identify Teacher Experts
  - Develop timelines
- Initial EdCredible meeting February 27
- Standards review is facilitated by the Bureau of Standards and Instructional Support
- Transparency and documentation is key

#### March 2019

 Contacted math and ELA professional organizations to request teacher expert designees to represent the organization during the standards review.



# **April 2019**

• The 9-12 standards review conducted by expert groups

## May 2019

- The 6-8 standards review conducted by expert groups
- By the end of May, the proposed FIRST DRAFT 9-12 and 6-8 standards were available in EdCredible for public comment

#### June 2019

- Initiate second draft based on input
- Public input of proposed FIRST DRAFT 9-12 and 6-8 standards in EdCredible continues
- The K-5 standards review conducted by expert groups



# July 2019

- Public input on proposed FIRST DRAFT K-5 standards in EdCredible
- Continue to update proposed first draft standards based on input

#### August 2019

- August 1, close public input of current K-12 standards
- Continue to update proposed FIRST DRAFT standards based on input

#### September 2019

- Proposed second draft of Florida's standards will be available for public input in EdCredible
- Hold roundtable meetings to gather stakeholder input



#### October 2019

- Hold roundtable meetings to gather stakeholder input
- Update K-12 standards based on final input

#### November 2019

• FDOE to prepare final standards and report

#### December 2019

• FDOE draft report to Commissioner

#### January 2020

• FDOE report to Governor for approval

# February – March 2020

• Florida State Board of Education approves



- Research
  - Defined college and career ready and how that is measured
  - Contacted Florida College System and University System
- Backward Design
  - Develop standards with the target or end goal in mind beginning with grades 9-12
- Analyzed other state standards
  - Represented the comparisons from other states and Florida on a spreadsheet
  - Side-by-side comparisons
- Analyzed assessment frameworks
  - SAT, ACT, NAEP, TIMSS, PISA



# **Success Criteria for Standards**

- Provide a roadmap to make Florida's standards number one in the nation.
- Support achievement as reflected on yearly state assessments, NAEP, ACT and SAT.
- Lead the nation in students graduating high school, as well as earning college degrees, industry certifications and other highquality credentials.
- Provide a logical, sequential progression of content that increases a student's knowledge and skills over time.
- Develop a standardized coding scheme.
- Have clear and concise standard language.

- Points of consideration when reviewing standards were provided to experts.
  - Public Feedback
  - Comparison to other states' standards
  - Clarity and Concision
  - Career-Ready Considerations
  - Student Achievement



# **Standards Review Options**

- Eliminate Standard (requires comment that should include why the standard should be eliminated).
- Revise Standard (requires comment that should include recommended edits for the standard).
- Move Standard (requires comment and reviewer should include the grade level change and any edits to the standard).
- No Change Needed (*no comment required*).



# **Three layers of review**

- Teacher Experts
  - Identified by Florida professional organizations
  - Required to gather input from organizational members
- Specialty Stakeholders
  - Identified by FDOE and public stakeholders
  - Represent a wide scope of expertise
- Public
  - 24 hour electronic access to review platform

# **Teacher Expert Groups**

- Florida professional organizations were contacted to solicit teacher expert nominees
- Nominees provided information including current résumé
- Nominees were screened by FDOE personnel and notified of selection
- Teacher experts and organization presidents were advised to provide a mechanism to allow voice from membership



# **Teacher Expert Groups**

- The process began with the individuals reviewing the current standards and marking with the item choices (keep, revise, move, eliminate) provided to the general public
- The initial baseline data was assembled into charts based on groups
- Groups containing experts from all professional organizations held consensus calls

# Grades 9-12 Review (April, 2019)

- FDOE team developed rapport with teacher experts
- Teacher experts for 9-12 : 39
- Florida organizations represented: 12
- Number of small groups of standards: 14
- Total Formal/Scheduled Webinars : 38
- Ongoing two way communication between FDOE Team and designees via email
- Consensus process is public, transparent, and documented





# Grades 9-12 Review (April, 2019)

- FDOE
  - Stressed "clear & concise"
  - Sent considerations documents as resources
  - Included assessment frameworks
  - Gathered public feedback
- Teacher Expert Reviewers
  - Wrote proposed standards with the students and parents in mind
  - Took ownership of the review process
  - Conscientiously gathered feedback from organization to be included in review
  - Shown feedback, including possible revisions, from experts within group
  - <u>Reached consensus during the webinars</u>

# Math and ELA Standards Review

- A total of 39 teacher experts representing 12 organizations worked in 14 small groups and participated in a total of 38 webinars during the month of April.
- In May, a total of 45 teacher experts representing 14 organizations worked in 16 small groups and participated in a total of 41 webinars.
- In June, as we continue working with expert groups on proposed standards for grades K-5, we welcome ongoing input from members of the public, and we look forward to holding public hearings this fall.



- Standards review will be conducted during 2019, with recommendations due to Governor DeSantis January 1, 2020
- No changes to statewide assessments or school grades calculation in 2018-2019 and 2019-2020 related to the executive order
- Extensive public input opportunities are available, before the recommendations are submitted and again through State Board of Education rulemaking process
- Instructional materials adoption timeline has been revised
